



TYPICAL FIXTURE



1. Drill 9/16" diameter mounting holes in mounting surface at 1-1/2" on center.
2. Lower 1/4" pipe nipple through mounting holes. Place clamp plate in position and secure table lamp in place by tightening lock nuts.

NOTE:

1. 1/4" pipe nipple length protruding from base of table lamp may be adjusted by turning the 1/4" pipe nipple clockwise or counter clockwise.
2. If with top lens, remove protective coating from lens. Remove finial layon lens and secure shade and lens with finial.
