








- Swivel Plate and fasten Swivel Ball Retainer and ground wire with screws provided.
- 3. Fasten cast swivel plate to junction box with 8/32 screws.
- 4. Insert stem through canopy and then attach the Jam Nut and Cable Collar.
- Lift Fixture up and insert Stainless Steel Cables (x2) into Cable Grippers on the Cable Collar. 5.
- Make final adjustments to height, pull fixture wires through the cable collar/ Stem and make all 6. connections per local and national codes (see page 3 for typical wire color scheme).
- 7. Lift Canopy in place and secure with screws provided. 8. If your installation requires the DMX Control Cable, it must be routed outside the junction box due to the low voltage class of the cable.





1) See Tube Hook detail for supporting Acrylic housing

- 2) Remove Thumb Screws to remove Downlight Bezel
- 3) Twist Downlight Reflector counter clockwise
- 4) Remove (4) Hex Nuts to remove Tube Support
- 5) Remove the acrylic housing by sliding it down through the bottom.
- 6) Remove (2) Screws attaching the door of wire body and pivot it open

DMX-CONTROL INSTRUCTIONS (RGB LEDS ONLY)

- 1. See VisaLighting.com/DMXguide for further details on installing a DMX system.
- 2. To RDM address turn switch 11 ON and switch 10 OFF (Default).
- 3. To manually address with the DIP switches turn switch 10 and 11 OFF and use 'Chart B-Euro DMX 512' to address. Availible at VisaLighting.com/DMXchartB. Example: (Ch# =Dip Switch ON) (1= 0) (4= 1, 2) (7= 2, 3) (512 = 1, 2, 3, 4, 5, 6, 7, 8, 9).
- While this controller will take a set of 4 DMX addresses only 3 DMX addresses are being used so the 4. fixtures can be addressed in groups of 3.




