Allowable main cable diameters

(Stainless steel grade per structural engineer specification)

Mounting hardware is provided to attach cable(s) to the luminaire, below are the diameters that will fit with the standard hardware:

Direct to main cable (top and bottom): 3/32" - 1/4"

Optional secondary cross cable: 1/16" - 3/16" (max of 1/8" if main cable is 1/4")

The fixture must be suspended if the main catenary cable is larger that 1/4" DIA.

WARNING

Catenary cables, cable ends, structural masts and fittings for attachment to the building are provided by others. A qualified structural engineer should be consulted to ensure the integrity of the specific application.

Different catenary hardware may be required depending on the application. The structural engineer should be provided with information about the luminaire: dimensions, weight, effective projected area, allowable cable diameters (see specification sheet) and a description of how the cables will be mounted (see sheet 2). The structural engineer should also be provided details of the application such as: the quantity, locations, limiting sag, structural mounting points and environmental condition such and ice, wind and corrosion effects.

When using electrical equipment, basic safety precautions should always be followed, including the following:

Read all instructions carefully before installing and save for future use.
Make sure all connections are in accordance with the National Electrical Code and local regulations.
To avoid possible electric shock, be sure the power supply is turned off before servicing or installing the fixture

Service should be performed by qualified personnel.



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TOOLS REQUIRED: 1/8" Allen wrench (mounting screws/set screws)




Typical fixture install

- Remove (4) screws from the top of the 1. mounting puck.
- 2. Install properly sized cables (by others) into the mounting groove.
- 3. Reinstall the (4) screws.
- 4. Tighten the (4) set screws until the catenary cable is properly secured.

Mid-run splice connection install (option)

- See typical fixture install instructions. 1.
- 2. Remove (4) screws to gain access to mid-run splice box compartment.
- 3. Install the power cords and make all connections in accordance with local codes.
- 4. Reinstall screws taking care to not pinch any wires.

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



If there is a continuing fixture, connect the line votage input of the next RMB to the line voltage output of the RMB. If there is not a continuing fixture, plug the quick connect line voltage output with the Quick Connect Cap.

- 2. To RDM address turn switch 11 ON and switch 10 OFF (Default).
- 3. To manually address with the DIP switches turn switch 10 and 11 OFF and use 'Chart B-Euro DMX 512' to address. Availible at VisaLighting.com/DMXchartB. Example: (Ch# =Dip Switch ON) (1= 0) (4=1, 2) (7=2, 3) (512=1, 2, 3, 4, 5, 6, 7, 8, 9).
- 4. While this controller will take a set of 4 DMX addresses – only 3 DMX addresses are being used so the fixtures can be addressed in groups of 3.
